Mark is the Associate Dean for Post Graduate Students, Deputy Head of the Graduate School and also a Senior Lecturer in Immunology, at St George's University of London.

Mark's academic career started at the University of Leeds and he went on to complete a PhD at UCL. Since then he has been involved in research investigating the immunotherapy of autoimmune disease and, most recently, cancer. He is particularly interested in the role of the non-conventional T cell.

He has had about a dozen PhD students through his laboratory and has been struck by the lack of applicants from ethic minority communities for advertised studentships. This led to a collaboration with ERA, for which he is an Academic Advisor, trying to raise awareness of the Academic career path in these communities.
